



Route Information

Boarding the Right Bus:
Some routes cover a common section and then split into "A" and "B" to cover different destinations at the end of the route. It is important to check both the route name and the destination signs to ensure that you are travelling in the right direction and towards your final destination. The route number and name are displayed on the bus' large overhead sign and also audibly announced when the bus stops and the doors are opened.

The purpose of splitting routes is to make the LTC as efficient as possible.

Interlined Routes:
The following routes are "interlined", which means that when the bus completes its first route, the bus changes to a second route and continues its trip. Interlining makes travel more convenient because it reduces the need to transfer between routes.
